Our Mission: Sparking a passion for STEM, inspiring generations of young learners to innovate and create, utilizing art as a catalyst for exploration.




Kids Discovery Factory will feature:

- 10,000 square feet of interactive STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, the Arts and Mathematics) exhibits that will develop STEM skills and inspire innovation as visitors invent, create and imagine
- **Smithsonian SparkLab!** Invention Center through the SparkLab National Network, part of the Smithsonian's Lemelson Center for the Study of Invention and Innovation
- 7 themed galleries, 3 Innovation Labs, an Innovation Showcase and a **two-story STEAM Climber**

- Interactive Factory Exhibit Area that will engage visitors in the process of manufacturing a box and widgets to go inside. Focused on new technologies, the Factory will include a **Baxter cooperative robot** that interacts with visitors and a 3D printer
- Field trips, in-classroom support and outreach programming will support regional schools and community groups
- Hands on learning experiences for kids birth to 14 years old
- Evening family programming and immersive learning opportunities
